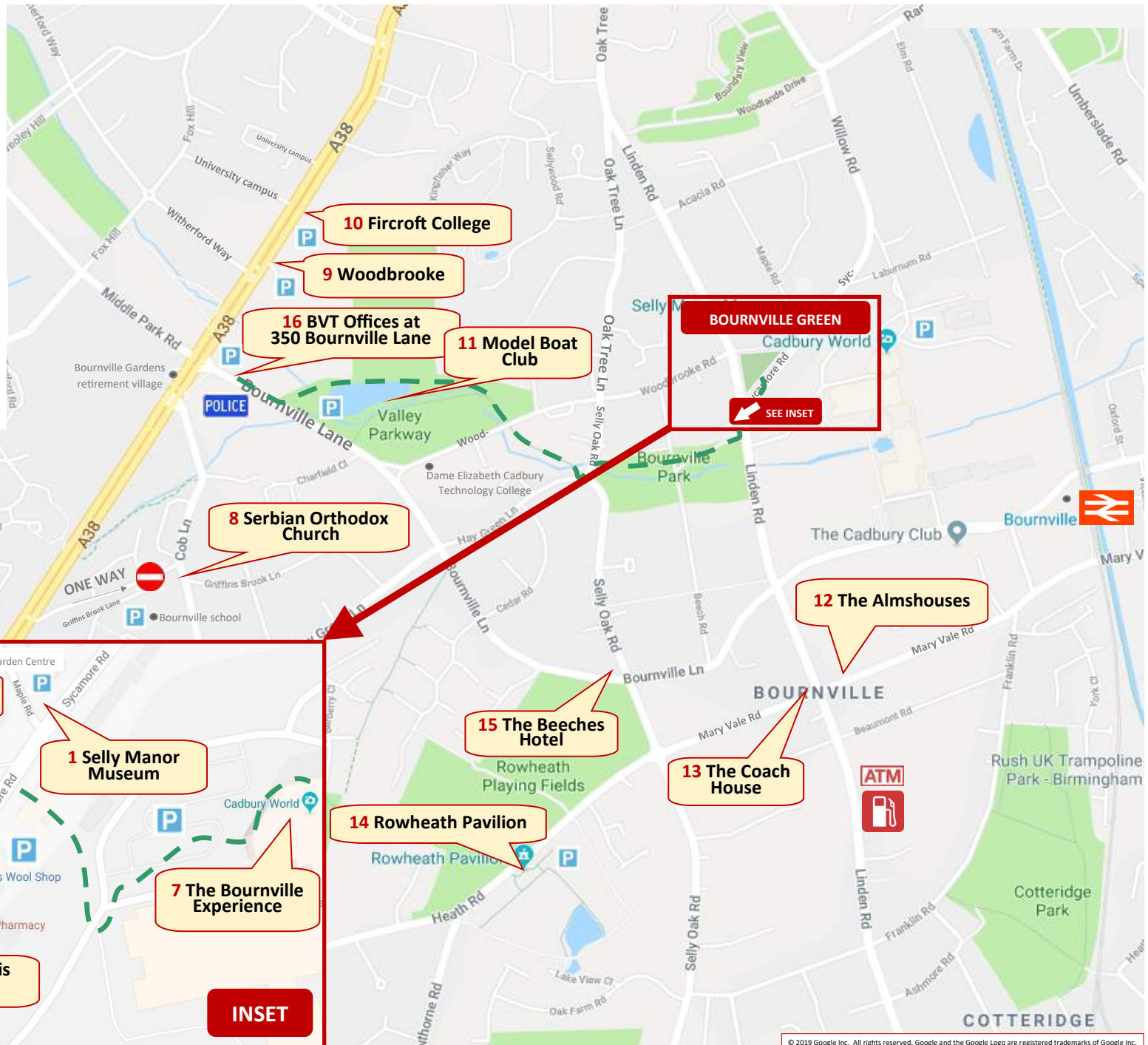

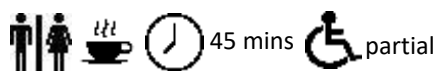
Enjoy Bournville by bike or on foot by following the green trail to link the sites

Maple Road, B30 2AE

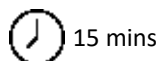
A Tudor manor and medieval hall rebuilt by the Cadbury family

Linden Road, B30 1JY

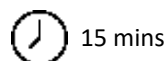
Pre-booked tours to climb the tower and enjoy magnificent views

Sycamore Road, B30 2AA

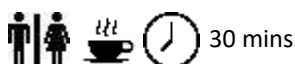
Early Christian basilica style church, consecrated in 1925

92 Griffins Brook Lane, B30 1QG

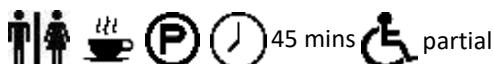
A beautiful Serbian Orthodox Church with spectacular frescoes

Mary Vale Road, B30 2DJ

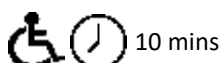
A rare chance to tour the Almshouses built in 1898 for Richard Cadbury

76 Selly Oak Road, B30 1LS

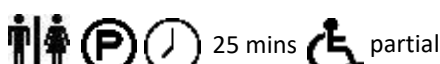
A beautiful historic building built in the early 1900's by the Cadbury family
