Maple Road, B30 2AE

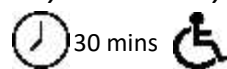
A Tudor manor and medieval hall rebuilt by the Cadbury family

Bournville Green, B30 1AA

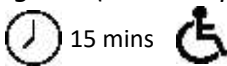
Built in 1914, the Rest House will be displaying the Museum of Us exhibition. Plus, see vintage vehicles on the village green (weather permitting)

Sycamore Road, B30 2AA

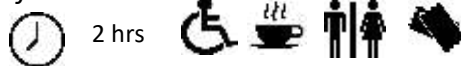
Early basilica style church, with a beautiful interior

Linden Rd, B30 1JR

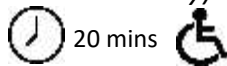
Enjoy a pre-bookable presentation (limited availability)

83 Bournville Lane, B30 2HP

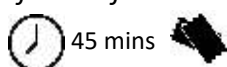
The former bank and estate office open for the first time this century

Mary Vale Road, B30 2DH

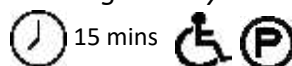
Guided pre-booked tours of this unique building built by Richard Cadbury

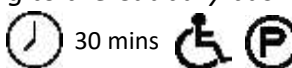
A rich treasure trove of material relating to the Cadbury business
