The Great Fire of London

key stage 1



Join our experienced learning team for an interactive storytelling experience from the comfort of your classroom!

Meet Samuel Pepys, Thomas Farriner and King Charles II as they tell the story of why the fire started and how it was put out. The children will act out key characters, the crooked houses of London and the raging flames of the great fire itself. They will also discover more about the effects of the fire by handling our replica objects.

This will be followed by a fun Great Fire of London activity for the whole class. Choose from making a London firescape picture or learn to write like Samuel Pepys.

This session supports a number of Key Stage 2 Curriculum elements including a local history study and a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066.

This session supports a number of Key Stage 3 Curriculum elements including ideas, political power, industry and empire: Britain 1745-1901, a local history study and a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066.

Practicalities

Being Covid Secure

The Selly Manor Education Team will take precautions to ensure our visit to your school is Covid Secure. We will wear face coverings when delivering the session, socially distance and ensure all resources are quarantined before and after each school visit.

We will adhere to your school's requirements and discuss this with you before our visit.

Numbers

Our outreach sessions are best suited for one class of children containing no more than 35 pupils. We can deliver to multiple classes at the same time but this may restrict the experience, or we are happy to run multiple sessions each day.

Cost

Each session will last for approximately 1 ½ hours. The cost is £120 for the first class session, subsequent class sessions are £90 per class.

There is no additional charge for travelling to schools in Birmingham. Schools outside Birmingham will be subject to an additional mileage charge – this will be calculated during booking, depending on the distance travelled.

Cancellation

If you are forced to cancel at short notice due to Covid then we will be happy to rearrange your booking for an alternative date at no extra cost. If you cancel the booking for any other reason we require 5 working days' notice, failure to do so will result in the full cost being charged.

Times

We are happy to run our outreach sessions at any time to suit you, dependent on our availability.

Resource Pack, Risk Assessment & Pre-Visit Preparation

A resource pack and risk assessment will be sent out to all booked and confirmed groups. We have Public Liability Insurance and a certificate can be provided upon request.

We will also be very happy to discuss your school's specific needs with teachers before the visit. We aim for all our sessions to be tailor-made to suit you.

Location and Travel

We are happy to travel to schools across the West Midlands. If you fall outside of this area we would recommend our digital sessions as an alternative. We will travel to Birmingham schools at no additional cost. Schools outside Birmingham will be subject to an additional mileage charge.
